## Americana Star

### Supplies

Tin Star  
Americana Patterned Scrapbook Paper  
Mod Podge  
Foam Brush  
Embellishments  
Tools: Paper Trimmer, Ruler, Pencil and Scissors  
Optional: Photographs with images small enough to fit on the surface of your star.



### Directions

1. Measure one point (arm) of the star and subtract 1/4" from each length.
  2. Cut your paper and photos to fit the sides of your star .  
*Hint: It may help to use a piece of cardstock or cardboard to create a template of one side of the star to use when cutting your paper and photos.*  
*Design idea: Take your template and cut in half to allow for more options for photos and patterns.*
  3. Decoupage your photos and paper to your tin star.  
Decoupage Instructions: Use the Mod Podge aka decoupage as a glue to secure your paper and photos to the tin star and as a sealer over the top of everything. If your paper starts to bubble just keep smoothing it down with your fingers or foam brush. Note: The decoupage does dry clear but the finish will depend on whether you choose matte or glossy decoupage.
  4. Apply your embellishments.
