



Happy Haunting Shadow Box

Supplies

- Chipboard Tags
- Paper - Jeepers Creepers
- Paper - Fright Night
- Paper - Word Play
- Ranger - Ultra Thick Embossing Enamel Black
- Mod Podge
- Ranger - Glossy Accents
- Tim Holtz - Distress Embossing Ink
- Ranger - Alcohol Ink - Sunset Orange
- Pop Dots
- Black Ribbon
- Wood Shadow Box Sierra Pacific
- Decorative Crown tin Strip - Sierra Pacific
- Metal Flower - Sierra Pacific

Directions:

1. Cut Black and Orange boarder off of Fright Night, set aside
2. Trace out a 4" x 6" rectangle out of Fright Night making sure to include the two owls the haunted house
3. With second sheet of Fright Night fussy cut the two owls, two bats and haunted house
4. With pop dots adhere the fussy cut images over the 4" x 6" rectangle scene. Adhere images on top of like image. Except the smallest bat, adhere this bat to the top center
5. From chipboard tafs punch out the Purple Frame, Hallowe'en Greetings Tab, small purple Wishing You A Jolly Hallowe'en tag
6. Cut 1" off the bottom of the Purple Frame
7. With Pop Dots adhere Hallowe'en Greetings Tab on a diagonal to the top right hand side of the purple frame
8. Using 5 layers of Pop dots adhere the puple frame just over the Haunted House
9. Adhere the small Jolly Hallowe'en tag to the bottom right hand side of Purple Frame
10. Using Glossy Accents adhere the Fright Night Scene to the back frame insert
11. Cut out four strips of paper from Word Play, two strips that measure 1 1/4"x5 1/4" and two strips that measure 1 1/4"x3 1/2"
12. Adhere to inside of Frame using mod podge. One layer on wood, one layer on the back side of Word Play (stripe) adhere, and add one more layer mod podge to top of Word Play (word side up)
13. Cut out four strips of Jeeper's Creeper's. Two strips measuring at 1 1/2"x6 3/4" and two strips measuring at 1 1/2"x4 5/8"
14. Adhere to the outside of frame. Laying down one layer of Mod Podge to the wood, one layer of Mod Podge to the back side of Jeeper's Creeper's (Playing Card side) adhere to wood, and add one more layer of Mod Podge to the top of Jeeper's Creeper's (spider side up)
15. Cut to fir the Fright Night black and orange frame to fit the top side of frame. Cutting each end at a 45° angle, piecing the frame together. Adhere with the Mod Podge, one layer on the wood, one layer on backside of paper and one layer on the top side of the border after it has been adhered to the frame. Let dry
16. Apply Sunset Orange Alcohol Ink to the Sierra Pacific Metal Flower, set a side to dry
17. Take the Decorative Tin Strip cut off a piece

- measuring at 6³/₄"
18. Dab Distress Embossing Ink to the top of tin strip, apply generously
 19. Pour Ultra Thick Embossing Enamel over to top of tin strip. Shake off extra
 20. Using a heat tool melt the UTEE, make sure not to touch. Let cool down
 21. Use 1 yard of the Black ribbon and tie around Jeoper's Creeper's Frame. Tying a knot at the top, apply two chipboard tags of your choice and continue to tie a bow with ribbon
 22. Using Glossy Accents adhere the black tin strip to the front of the frame, on top of the tin strip adhere the orange flower to the right hand side. Let dry
