# Minkee Cuddle Soft Chevron

## **Supplies:**

- 2 Background Fabric
- 2 1/4 Chevron Fabric
- 1/3 Binding
- 2 5/8 Backing

### **Directions:**

#### **Background:**

- Cut a 20" strip then cut a 20" x 20" square from that strip.
- Cut the remaining 20" into 10" x 40".
- Cut the remaining fabric into  $10'' \times 60''$  strips. You should have two  $10'' \times 40''$  strips and five  $10'' \times 60''$  strips.

#### **Chevron:**

- Cut the chevron fabric into eight 10" x 60" strips.
- Cut one strip of the chevron fabric into two 10" x 30" strips (Tip: These will be used for Row 1.)

#### Quilt:

- Spread out the backing fabric. Using the 505 spray place the batting onto the backing fabric.
- 2. Trim the batting so that it is the same size as the backing, pinning the sides so that the fabric does not move.
- 3. Draw a straight line on top of the batting/back fabric 1" down.
- 4. Measure in 14" from the right side and place the square on the line you just made. Spray flat and pin down.
- 5. Take Row 1, the 10" x 30" chevron fabric strip, and place it on top of the square then align the edges. Pin the edges down.
- 6. Start in the center and sew using 1/4" 3/8" seam flip, spray, and pin.
- 7. Take one chevron fabric strip and place it on the left side of the square.
- 8. Start in the center and sew using  $\frac{1}{4}$ "  $\frac{3}{8}$ " seam flip, spray, and pin.
- 9. Take Row 1-B the 10" x 40" of the background fabric and place on the chevron fabric, aligning the edges.
- 10. Repeat steps 5-9 until the quilt is completed. To cover the bottom corners, use the extra fabric from Row 3 and 5.
- 11. Trim the bottom of your quilt at the point of row 6.

















## Sewing the Quilt:

This quilt is constructed with the "sew and flip" method. This means that the strips are sewn onto a foundation, then the strips are flipped down and the next strip is sewed on.

Steps 1, 3, and 5 display the strips being sewn onto the square.

Steps 2, 4, and 6 show the strips being flipped down after they be
