



Light n' Feathery Tulle Dress

Supplies:

- Tulle Rolls 6" x 25" yd.
- 2 ½ Rolls Green Tulle
- ½ Roll Pink Tulle
- 3 ½ Rolls Cream Tulle
- Crocheted Headbands (2 – 1 ¾") (1 – 3")
- Cardboard piece

Directions:

1. Choose crochet headbands for desired width of bodice. Crocheted headbands will fit up to an average size 6 in little girls.
2. Sew headbands together with elastic thread. (Tip: make sure the two headbands line up like a checker board for weaving tulle.)
3. Measure child from the armpit down to the ground or to desired length. Cut cardboard 6" x the length measured.
4. Start at one end and with the tulle wrap around the cardboard to cut multiple pieces at once. Trim the tulle with scissors at the end you started with. (Tip: It is best to use the under lining color first because you can add additional tulle for a fuller look later.)
5. Using the slip knot method, attach your tulle to the top of the bodice and weave tulle down through to the bottom. (Tip: Use a size K 6.5 mm. crochet hook to weave.)
6. Now trim the cardboard down the width of the bodice for additional tulle at the bottom. Wrap the tulle around the cardboard and cut.
7. Using the slip not method add additional tulle for fullness along the bottom of the bodice.
8. Measure out elastic of your choice for over the shoulder, keeping in mind the stretchiness of elastic. Sew to the top of the bodice with elastic thread.
9. Trim the tulle for sleeves. (Tip: 8" pieces work pretty well.) Use the slip knot method to attach the elastic over the shoulder.
10. Embellish dress as desired. (Tip: You can use burlap to make ribbon roses, and accent those with complimentary ribbons and bows.)
