



Foxy Knit Scarf

Supplies:

- Bellini Yarn: Venice (Your Choice of Color)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 (8 mm.)

Directions:

(Tip: Bellini yarn is constructed with a 'ladder' along one edge. The spaces in this ladder edge should be counted as loops.)

Cast on 3 sts as follows:

1. From the end of the yarn, skip the first two loops, this end is the yarn tail, then insert your needle into the next loop.
2. Keeping this loop on your needle, insert your needle into each of the next two loops – three sts (loops) on the needle.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) as follows:

1. Hold the needle with the cast on sts in your left hand and the empty needle in your right hand.
2. Insert right hand needle into the first st on the left hand needle as if to knit, then into the next loop on the working yarn. Pull the loop of working yarn through the st on the left needle, and then slip the st off the left hand needle – 1 st knitted onto right hand needle.
3. Insert right hand needle into the next st on the left hand needle as if to knit, then into the next loop on the working yarn. Pull the loop of working yarn through the st on the left needle, and then slip the st off the left hand needle – you have now knit the next st.
4. Repeat Step 3 to knit the last st.
5. Continue in Garter st until almost all the yarn has been used and about five loops of working yarn remain. Continue to use yarn loops as sts, then bind off.

(Tip: use your fingers to weave the yarn ends into the fabric of the scarf.)
